

Revised C4RWLU June 4, 2012 meeting minutes

Options presented at the C4RWLU meeting included the following to address rejection of referendum petition:

1. Accept defeat and disband.
2. Litigate the Clerk's decision.
3. Lobby the current assembly for repeal.
4. Lobby the legislature to repeal the State Statutes that granted planning and zoning powers to second class boroughs without public approval.
5. A state-wide petition drive to repeal AS 29.40.
6. Replace the current Borough Assembly with a more conservative group.
7. Legal review of the constitutional issues raised. Specifically the Alaska Constitution, Article 8 Section 16, dealing with property rights, taxation, eminent domain and equal protection issues

Option #1 was unanimously rejected by the group with little discussion.

Option #2 was rejected for practical reasons based on advice from our legal advisors.

Option #3 was adopted and a sub-committee was formed to lobby the current assembly for repeal of KPB Ordinance 2011-12. This committee will be chaired by Stacy. Members include: Wayne, George, Joe and Lou.

Option #4 was adopted and a sub-committee was formed to lobby the State Legislature to repeal provisions of State Statutes that grant planning and zoning powers to second class boroughs without public approval of affected voters. This committee will be chaired by Fred. Members include: Bill, George, Joe and Mike

Option #5 was rejected for practical reasons.

Option #6 was also adopted and a sub-committee formed with the task of recruiting and supporting the election of conservative assembly candidates. This committee will be chaired by Mike. Members include: Jim, Jerry, Wayne, Christine, Joe and Lou.

Option #7 has been forwarded to the attorney for review.

Each committee should do their work outside the general meeting. Bringing forward complete plans to the whole group for final approval at the next scheduled meeting. It is suggested you set up separate committee meeting and/or communicate via email or phone to accomplish your tasks outside the general meeting.

All concerned citizens should be encourage to attend and become part of at least one of these important committees. The next meeting is scheduled for 5:30 pm Monday (6/11) upstairs at the American Legion in Kenai.
